LET'S GET STARTED!

- 1) You should already have picked up a parking pass at the main security gate. Please display this pass at all times in the front windshield of your vehicle while on property.
- 2) As a renter at Sunrise Country Club you will receive full privileges in the dining room, lounge and grille. If you would like to use the dining room, lounge, or grille you must open a temporary club account. To open an account, you will need to fill out a credit card authorization form at the main office. A Discover, Amex, Visa or MC and proper identification will be required. A current lease agreement will need to be on file.
- 3) You'll notice there are equity and non-equity rental fees for golf, tennis, pickleball, and fitness. The office staff will be able to tell you if your condo has an equity membership to determine your pricing.

IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW

- Attire Clubhouse: Appropriate golf, tennis and casual attire (jeans permitted) is allowed. No pool attire is permitted in the clubhouse at any time. Special events may have a dress code.
- Attire Grille: Proper swimsuit cover-ups are permitted; footwear must be worn in the grille and outside patio area.
- Cell Phone Policy: Audible ringers must be turned off while in the clubhouse.
- Citrus Fruit: The fruit trees are considered communal. Citrus fruit may be picked, within reason, by any resident or guest for their personal enjoyment.
- Golf Carts: You must have a valid driver's license to operate a golf cart on property.
- Golf Course Safety: For safety reasons, tenants as well as all children are required to stay off the golf course and cart paths at all times. The 3ft. tall white stakes on the golf course side of the unit define the golf course boundaries.
- Guests: Visitors must be registered at the front gate before they can be allowed to enter the property. Please call the security gate at 760.328.7277 to leave their name and date/time of arrival.
- Pets: Pets must be on a leash at all times. Unleashed pets are in violation of city law. Pets are not permitted on the golf course, cart paths, practice facilities, or in pool areas. No more than two pets are allowed per residence. Pet owners are responsible for cleaning up after pets.
- **Pools:** Appropriate bathing suit attire is required at all times. Pool hours are from 7 am to 10 pm. There are no lifeguards on duty; swim at your own risk. Children under the age of 14 are not allowed in the pool area unless supervised by a responsible adult. Observe all posted rules.
- Smoking: All Sunrise Country Club buildings are non-smoking facilities.
- Trash Disposal: Reference Article X1V of the SCC Homeowners Association Rules & Regulations for details.
- **Vehicles:** The speed limit is 25 miles per hour. Vehicles parked in driveways are not to extend into the street.
- Wi-Fi: Complimentary Wi-Fi is available in the grille, fitness/activity center, and clubhouse pool area.
